

## **PAYMENT OPTIONS**

Below is a list of the available payment plans offered by PhlebotomyU and are applicable for the Phlebotomy Full Course only.  
We accept cash, check, credit, and debit cards

The current cost of the Phlebotomy Full Course is \$2,900.

### **Available Discounts**

- The first 4 students to pay in full for their class will receive a \$400 discount off the class. The total cost of the course will be \$2,500 instead of \$2,900.
- If you are not one of the first 4 students to pay in full, you can receive a \$200 discount off the class if you pay in full before the first day of class. The total cost of the course will be \$2,700 instead of \$2,900.
- PhlebotomyU offers an additional \$200 discount off the cost of the course if you are military or a hospital/clinic employee and provide a copy of your ID card.
- PhlebotomyU also can also offer group discounts if you and a friend enroll in the same class. Please inquire with the Admin staff for pricing. Note, group discounts cannot be applied in addition to a military or hospital/clinic employee discount.

### **Payment Plan**

We can offer interest free weekly payments for students who are enrolled in the class.

1. You must register for the course and pay the \$250 non-refundable registration fee
2. You must submit a deposit of \$250 prior to the start of class
3. A minimum weekly payment of \$100 must be made every week beginning on the first day of class.

In order to set up the Payment Plan, students will need to execute a Payment Agreement and set up an automatic recurring payment by providing your banking information or your credit/debit card information. As long as you are current on payments, you will be eligible to take the National Exam, participate in the Practical and complete a clinical externship. However, you will not receive your completion documents until you have paid your balance off in full.

### **Other Payment Options**

Our program is too small and does not qualify for **federal financial aid**. However, we are willing to work with any 3rd Party Payers, pending that our program meets their financial assistance criteria.

PhlebotomyU can work with some 3rd Party Payers who are able to offer students financial assistance. Some organizations that we have worked with in the past include: MyCAA for military spouses, Veterans Village of San Diego, Worker's Comp and Department of Rehabilitation.

You will need to contact these organizations directly to see if you qualify for their financial assistance.
